

Transport

The Management of Bai Kabibai and Hansraj Morarji Charity Trust has always placed the highest priority on the safety and security of its students and has implemented numerous measures to maintain a secure environment within the Andheri Campus. Transport safety forms a critical component, and transport carrying school children are required to strictly comply with the safety norms and guidelines prescribed by the Central and State Governments. While Bai Kabibai and Hansraj Morarji Charity Trust and its schools at the Andheri Campus neither own transport vehicles nor have any contractual arrangement with transporters or school bus operators, a Transport Management Committee (TMC), comprising parent representatives from all schools within the campus, has been constituted to safeguard parents' interests. The TMC has shortlisted two transporters, namely Adeena Travels and Khodaiji Bus Service, and is responsible for negotiating rates, finalising routes, and ensuring compliance with all prescribed safety norms. Comprehensive guidelines issued by various Government authorities are available with the TMC. Parents are at liberty to choose any mode of transport for their wards; however, they must ensure that the selected mode complies with all prescribed safety requirements. In the event that a parent opts for a transport arrangement that does not adhere to the laid down safety norms, such decision shall be entirely at their own risk, and the school shall bear no responsibility or liability in this regard.
